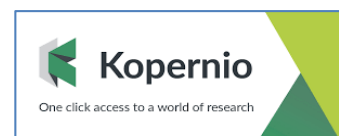
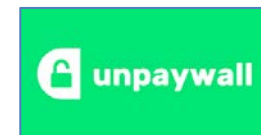
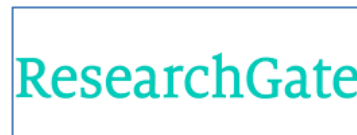
[IDRC Connect](#) is the collaboration portal for IDRC-funded project teams and responsible program officers.
